the whole phleb.



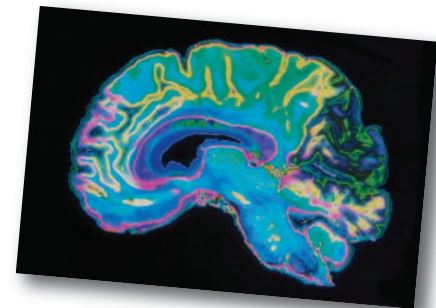
...you use DNA, DNR and DMV interchangeably.
